

THE RICHARD AND ELEANOR IMAI 2018 SHIN BUDDHIST SCHOLARSHIP Information, Procedures and Requirements

The mission of this scholarship award is to (1) grant financial support to deserving Shin Buddhist youths in their pursuit of higher education and (2) concomitantly enhance their practice of and commitment to Shin Buddhist principles and teachings throughout their lifetime.

1. Scholarships of at least \$2000.00 each are awarded to help meet the cost of education at any accredited university, college or vocational/technical post-secondary school in the USA and its possessions.
2. Eligibility
 - a. Applicant must currently be a senior in high school residing on the island of Hawai'i.
 - b. Applicant must be a Jodo Shinshu Buddhist whose parents or guardians are dues paying temple members or himself/herself a dues paying member of Honpa or Higashi Hongwanji.
3. Materials submission
 - a. Part A - Application Form
 - b. Part B - Temple Activities Form
 - c. Part C - An essay limited to two pages or less, typewritten or word-processed.
 - d. Part D and E- School/Community Activities and Special Honors/ Awards Received.
 - e. Signed Release Clause.
 - f. High School transcript (seven semesters).
 - g. One wallet-size portrait photographs (head-shoulders photo) for publicity purposes. (Scanned if applying via email.)
4. Application period: through May 9, 2018. Application with all required signatures, forms, letters and other materials must be received by the Honokaa temple delivered or postmarked on or prior to May 9, 2017. Applications will also be available at

5. Evaluation of applications
Review and judging of all applications shall be conducted by the Scholarship Committee, and its decision shall be final.
 - a. Criteria:
 1. Involvement in temple-related organizations and activities as described in Part B, "Temple Activities" of the application (30 points).
 2. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of Shin Buddhism as per the essay (30 points).
 3. High school academic performance (courses taken, grades obtained, GPA, class rank) as recorded in the applicant's high school transcript (10 points).
 4. Awards and Honors as per Parts B and E of Application (10 points).
 5. School and Community involvement as described in Part D and Part E of the application (10 points each).
6. Notification: Applicants shall be officially notified by mail or email regarding the decision of the Committee by May 16, 2018.
 7. Advisory: Please contact Miles Okumura (misterokumura@yahoo.com), committee chair, with questions, if any. You are advised to be certain that all procedures and applicable signatures, forms, lines, sections, etc. of the application are followed and completed. Incomplete applications will seriously affect the evaluation and point standing of the applicant.
